Akram R. Elias' has been a Mason since 1996, when he was initiated into Freemasonry at Potomac Lodge No. 5, F.A.A.M. in Washington, DC. Elias has been the head of several Masonic lodges in Washington, DC, and was installed as Grand Master of Masons of the District of Columbia on December 8, 2007 and ended his term in office on December 13, 2008. The Grand Master oversees all Masonic lodges within a Masonic jurisdiction. While Grand Master in 2008, the District of Columbia hosted the largest gathering of Masonic leaders in history – 121 Grand Lodges – with the 9th World Conference of Masonic Grand Lodges.

Elias, who is finishing co-authoring a book entitled “*America: A Masonic Project*” is a noted expert on the subject of Freemasonry and is known world-wide for his presentations on the Masonic history and symbolism of Washington, DC. He has appeared in many documentaries on Freemasonry to include:

He is a member of the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, specifically in Almas Temple Shrine of Washington D.C. He is also active in the Scottish Rite Valley of Washington, Orient of the District of Columbia, where he is a Past Wise Master of the Chapter of Rose-Croix. MWB Elias received the 33rd Degree, Sovereign Grand Inspector General (Honorary), on October 3rd, 2001.
